

DEIB Committee | Ally Membership Proposal

Background

The 2023 Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Committee provided feedback that time is the most significant hurdle they have to active Committee participation. For many, it is a barrier to continued committee member status and active engagement. Members asked if the DEIB Committee would consider expanding Committee participation in a way that could allow supporters to maintain a more passive involvement.

This proposal reflets a solution to address this suggestion through the creation of a DEIB Ally Membership status.

What does it mean for someone to maintain a CivicPlus Ally Membership Status?

- You are a supporter of the DEIB Committee
- You aim to be an ally at CivicPlus for women, BIPOC individuals, the Queer community,
 veterans, disabled individuals, and all others who identify as part of a historically excluded group

How does an employee become a CivicPlus DEIB Ally?

To achieve CivicPlus DEIB Ally status, an employee must complete any three of the following five steps:

☐You served a full term as a former or current DEIB Committee member
\square You can show that you completed 10 or more hours of self-paced DEIB learning and
educational content during your time at CivicPlus (sources include Lessonly, LinkedIn
Learning, third-part webinars, etc.)
\square You have attended 3 or more DEIB educational events during your time at CivicPlus
\square You have been a mentor or a mentee in the DEIB Mentorship Program
☐ You are a current member of one of CivicPlus' employee resource groups (ERG)



What are the benefits of being a CivicPlus DEIB Ally?

- You earn a digital certificate for your LinkedIn profile
- You are invited as an optional attendee for DEIB Committee Meetings and receive monthly agendas and meeting minutes
- You earn a custom icon for your Slack profile (note: Might need to be treated as a custom headshot frame/icon)
- You earn a \$10 store credit to purchase a DEIB t-shirt from Axomo
- You are invited to one Ally Membership virtual event annually
- Your feedback will be sought annually for constructive Committee improvement opportunities

Who will administer the CivicPlus DEIB Ally Program?

The DEIB co-chairs will administer the Ally Program or it can be managed by a sub-committee of DEIB Committee members.
